Remember that the happiest people are not those getting more but those giving more.



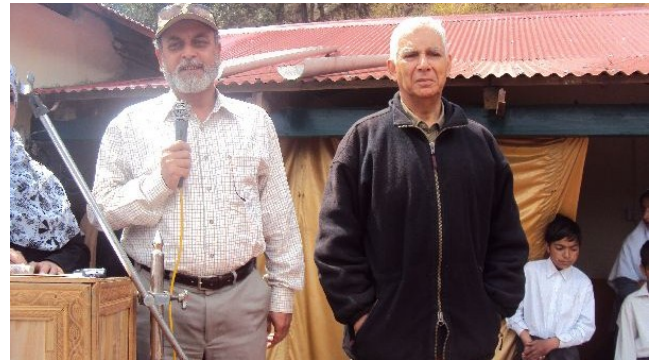
Aims & Objectives

including setting up of health care centers.



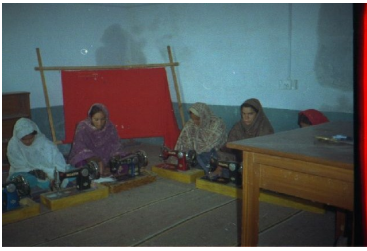
Annual Function

The land of school building was donated by locals at Changlagali. The trust undertook the construction work. Total covered area of the building is 3726 sqft at a cost of 2250/sqft (approx.). The market

value of the school building is 8.4 Million.



Vocational Training Institute



A vocational training institute is running successfully for women of village to enhance their skills and make them enable to maximize earnings for themselves. Trust provide this year 10 new sewing ma-

chines and other stitching material free of cost to all women learning in Trust vocational institute.



School Activities

- New academic session has been started this year and Trust provided copies, books and school bags to all students.
- Mountain school has been upgraded to middle level and registered with Abbottabad Board. Second batch of eight grade has passed from school.
- Sports day is held every week

in school to engage students in extracurricular activities. An activity room has been decorated for younger students.

A medical camp is held twice a month by the Trust for students and villagers. This year Trust provided vaccination facility to all students and other children of village free of cost. Medicines were provided and doctor & paramedical staff payments were made by the Trust.



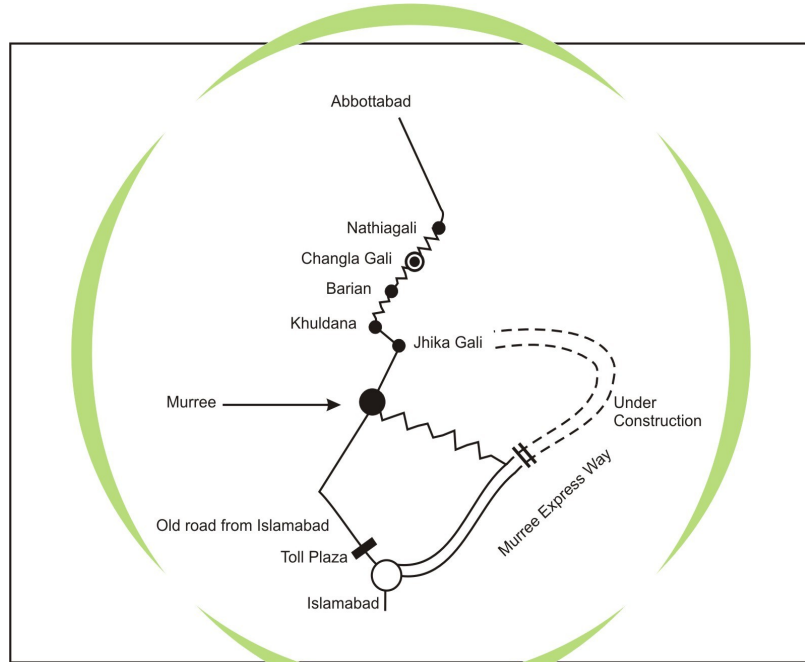
Plants Distribution
